University Scholarships 15/16

- Non-means tested scholarship worth £1,500 or £2,000
- UK and European Union graduates with a first or upper second class honours degree.
- Awarded on a 'first come first served' basis.
- Must apply prior to relevant deadline.

Deadline for February 2016 entry is **4:30 pm Friday 29th January 2016.***

- Currently only for English domiciled students
- Open for applications – Summer 2016
- Repay once earning above threshold of £21,000 yr
