


NEWPORT CITY CAMPUS MAP

Travel information

Travel information and directions to Newport City Campus are available on our website: www.southwales.ac.uk/visiting. The postcode for the campus is NP20 2BP.

There's no parking at the campus but parking in the Kingsway Centre is discounted by 20% for students, staff and visitors to the University. Just make sure you validate your ticket at reception.

The Kingsway Centre car park is right opposite the campus, on the other side of Usk Way. The postcode for the car park is NP20 1EU. For more information, visit: www.kingswaycentre.com

If you're travelling by train, Newport is the station closest to our City Campus – just a five minute walk away. You can use the map on the back of this programme to make your way here.

Registration

When you get here, head to the front of the building to register. Registration takes place at specific times, so you need to check the planner (pages 4 and 5) to see what time to register for your subject. To avoid queues at registration, don't forget to bring the letter we sent you with your QR code.

Campus tour

Our friendly student ambassadors will take you on a tour of Newport City Campus. This is your chance to see all our facilities and ask questions about day-to-day university life. Tours usually take around 20 minutes and you can book your place on these in the Information Fair.

Accommodation tour

Take a look at the accommodation we have available and find out about life in Halls of Residence from a student point of view. If you'd like to visit the Halls, which are right next to the campus, please book your place on a tour in the Information Fair. Tours take around 30 minutes. There will also be a member of staff available to answer your accommodation queries at the Information Fair throughout the Open Day.

Both tours are available from 8.30am, so if you want to go on either before your Welcome talk, come along for the first tour of the day.



INTERVIEW PREPARATION

For our Teacher Training and Social Work courses, prospective students will be interviewed as part of the application process.

To ensure you are fully prepared for these interviews, our Open Day includes bespoke sessions for each of these courses. Led by an academic member of staff who is directly involved with these interviews, the session will include how to prepare for the day and key tips on what our team will be looking for from prospective students.

It will also allow you to ask any questions about the process and how to approach it, which should help you succeed on the day and calm any nerves you may have.

1 Life in Newport

Newport offers an excellent quality of life, on the doorstep of some of the most beautiful parts of the country such as the Vale of Usk, the Wye Valley, the Heritage Coast and the Brecon Beacons National Park. The area has a wealth of heritage attractions, including Roman Caerleon – the amphitheatre, baths, barracks and National Roman Legion Museum, Tredegar House, Newport Transporter Bridge, Tintern Abbey and Chepstow Castle to name just a few. We also have the Newport Food Festival and our own jazz festival as well.

2 Newport sport

Newport offers a wide range of activities and world-class facilities for sports enthusiasts. Whatever your interests, the city offers plenty of ways to keep active and motivated throughout your studies. The Newport Centre, with its refurbished gym, is just opposite the campus and offers a great student membership deal, along with a number of other local fitness centres. You can also enjoy weekly sport with Gwent Dragons Rugby and Newport County FC, both within walking distance of the campus. The Newport International Sport Village is also home to the Wales National Velodrome. The facility is used regularly for national and international competitions, and is open for people to go and give it a try as well!

3 Things to do

You don't have to go far to find culture and entertainment in Newport. The Riverfront Theatre and Arts Centre is right next to the campus and offers comedy, live music and film screenings. Just a short walk into town, you'll reach the city's old Market Quarter. Newly redeveloped, it combines Newport's history with contemporary design, and there are lots of shops, cafes and bars for you to enjoy too.

4 Local music venues

Newport has a long tradition of live music, with many top bands playing in the city en route to making it big. Take a look at our top picks of venues to make sure you visit:

- Warehouse 54 – showcases the best of local new talent
- Le Pub – a Newport institution! Has been providing music events in the city for 20 years
- Riverside Tavern – great music, cheap drinks and friendly people
- Bassment Live – the main place to be on Friday and Saturday nights
