





Equivalencies to GCSE English Language or Welsh Language and Mathematics C grade for entry to Initial Teacher Training Education

Since September 2022 all ITE programmes in Wales require applicants to have a minimum C grade or equivalent in English Language or Welsh language and Mathematics at GCSE to be eligible to apply for entry to ITE courses. For courses of Primary programmes, a minimum C grade in GCSE Science is also required.

A grade 4 will be accepted as equivalent to the C grade requirement from the reformed GCSE's within England.

Both Mathematics and Numeracy at grade C will be accepted as equivalent to Maths from the changes within GCSE's in Wales.

<u>Equivelency testing is no longer accepted in Wales</u>. Qualifications being considered should be equivalent to a GCSE Grade C.

In order for a qualification to be recognized it must be awarded by a recognised awarding body that has awarding powers. It must be deemed equivalent to a C grade in English Language or Welsh Language, Mathematics and Science at GCSE.

Notes:

- Key Skills and Essential Skills qualifications in Application of Number and Communication are not sufficient to meet the requirements for entry to ITE.
- A GCSE Statistics Grade C is not an acceptable equivalent qualification.

Equivalent overseas qualifications

- The National Academic Recognition Information Centre (NARIC) provides guidance on whether an overseas qualification is comparable in standard to a given UK qualification but decisions about suitability for entry to ITE programmes remain at the discretion of ITE partnerships.
- There is a requirement that applicants are able to demonstrate equivalent qualifications at a level above C grade GCSE English Language or Welsh Language and Mathematics.
