## **PURPOSE OF THE PRIZE DRAW**

The University is offering this prize draw to encourage student participation in the National Student Survey (“NSS”). The NSS is a nationally recognised annual survey of final year undergraduates in the UK. The University uses NSS data to improve the learning experience and inform the quality assurance system regarding teaching quality.

The survey is administered by Ipsos, an independent market research agency, so answers remain anonymous at all times.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The University invites all final year undergraduate students to take part in our NSS Prize Draw. The prize draw will be for 10 winners to receive a £100 gift voucher.

## **THE RULES**

### **1 HOW TO ENTER**

- 1.1 The prize draw opened when you received an email on or around the 4 February (“the **Opening Date**”) to midnight, 30 April 2026 (“the **Closing Date**”).
- 1.2 There is a limit of one entry per person per prize draw. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted (save as set out in 2.1 below).
- 1.3 By clicking the Ipsos NSS Survey (“the **Survey**”) link which will be sent to you via email and completing the Survey, you will be automatically entered into the prize draw.
- 1.4 Please contact [studentsurveys@southwales.ac.uk](mailto:studentsurveys@southwales.ac.uk) if you wish to opt out of the prize draw.
- 1.5 The NSS Prize Draw 2026 is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.
- 1.6 All prize draw entries received after the Closing Date will not be accepted.
- 1.7 By submitting a prize draw entry to the NSS Prize Draw you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 1.8 The winning entrant(s) will then be drawn at random from all eligible entries within the applicable prize draw dates.

### **2 ELIGIBILITY**

- 2.1 The prize draw is only open to final year undergraduate students.

For the avoidance of doubt, University employees (and/or family members of University employees) who meet all of the above criteria are eligible to participate. **Individuals directly involved in administering or overseeing this prize draw are not eligible.**

- 2.2 In entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win.
- 2.3 The University reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize draw or where the University's records indicate that the entrant is not eligible.

### **3 THE PRIZE**

- 3.1 The prize is supplied by the University. Ten winners will be randomly selected from all eligible students to receive a £100 gift voucher. The University reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond the University's control makes it necessary to do so.
- 3.2 There is no alternative prize available and the prize is non-negotiable, non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternatives will be offered. The University's use of particular brands as prizes does not imply any affiliation with or endorsement of such brands.
- 3.3 The University does not provide any form of practical support for the prize; the prize is provided "as is". Prizes may be subject to their own terms and conditions issued by the relevant provider. To accept the prize, the winner must also accept any applicable prize terms and conditions (for example, gift card terms and conditions).

### **4 WINNER ANNOUNCEMENT**

- 4.1 The decision of the University is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 4.2 The University will contact the winner via the email address submitted on the Survey as soon as is practicable on or after Friday 29 May 2026. ("the **Announcement Date**"). The University will not amend this contact information once the prize entry has been submitted and all communication will be done using the email provided to the University.

### **5 CLAIMING THE PRIZE**

- 5.1 If you are the winner of a prize, you will have 7 days from the email sent to you on or after the Announcement Date to claim the prize by responding to our email to you provided during the verification process (detailed at Condition 2). - 5.2 The prize cannot be claimed by a third party on your behalf.

- 5.3 The University will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available or has not claimed their prize within the time specified, the University reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the runner-up entries that were received before the Closing Date of the relevant prize draw.
- 5.4 The University does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.
- 5.5 The University will make delivery arrangements through mutual agreement, within 14 days of the Announcement Date.

## **6 DATA PROTECTION**

## **7 GENERAL TERMS**

- 7.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the University, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to exclude you from participating in the prize draw.
- 7.2 The University reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 7.3 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the University and you agree to use only the courts of England and Wales.
- 7.4 In the event of any dispute, the decision of the University is final.
